

Thank you for your interest in the eye care programs offered at The Pacific Eye Institute (PEI). This application form is used for many of our programs so please take care to only fill out the portions that are applicable to you.

If you are applying for the **Postgraduate Diploma in Eye Care** or the **Postgraduate Certificate in Eye Care** you are expected to have completed a 2-4 week attachment at an eye clinic prior to beginning the program. We suggest that you do this as soon as possible.

It is expected that you will gain the following from an attachment:

- Become familiar with the role of an eye nurse/eye doctor
- Become familiar with the examination forms used in your clinics
- Become familiar with eye equipment available in your clinics
- If possible observe all aspects of eye care (operating theatre, outpatients, inpatients, refraction)
- Become familiar with what you will do upon graduation
- Become familiar with commonly prescribed eye medications, treatments and surgeries
- Become familiar with eye outreach

If you are applying for the **Postgraduate Diploma in Ophthalmology** you are expected to have a minimum of 2 years work experience as a medical practitioner and work in a regional hospital eye department for at least one year prior to beginning the program.

Attachment is not required for those applying for the **Postgraduate Certificate in Diabetes Eye Care**, the **Master of Community Eye Care** or the **Master of Medicine (Ophthalmology)**.

Please note that for the Master of Community Eye Care there is a distance learning option for Fiji National University courses. Please contact the Education Manager at PEI to request the document 'Master of Community Eye Care: Application Procedures' for more information (contact details on the last page).

This application **for PEI courses** consists of two main parts:

- Pacific Eye Institute application
- Fiji National University application

You must complete both applications and submit them with:

- Two certified copies of your academic transcript (medical school, nursing school, tertiary qualification, or highest secondary level achieved)
- Two certified copies of your birth certificate
- A copy of your curriculum vitae
- Eight passport-sized photos
- Proof of approval of sponsorship (if applicable)
